<u>Arika Lippstrew</u>-Mrs. Lippstrew thanked the board for allowing our school to be in session during the COVID pandemic. She also thanked them for making elective classes one of the priorities in our school. Mrs. Lippstrew shared with the board some of the pieces of work that her students have completed. She also talked about how she used technology in the Art room.
