- ➤ The Attendance report from May is included. Our attendance rate was 95% (Elementary 96%; Secondary 94%).
- ▶ I'll give an update at the meeting on our curriculum consortium. Ten school districts remain in the NE Consortium for Student Achievement and Growth (Akron, Fleming, Haxtun, Holyoke, Julesburg, Lone Star, Merino, Otis, Revere, and Wray). We will have our first training on June 14th and 15th and I will update you on that training Tuesday night.
